

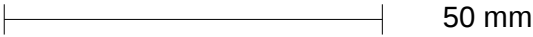
Print at 100% / Actual Size

Turn off Fit to Page, Shrink to Fit or borderless expansion.

Select the matching paper size. Verify the printed references before use.

1. Check the scale on paper

Use a physical ruler: the line below must measure exactly 50 mm.



Bank-card outline

85.60 x 53.98 mm

Match the straight edges.

Card corners may be rounded.

Check both width and height.

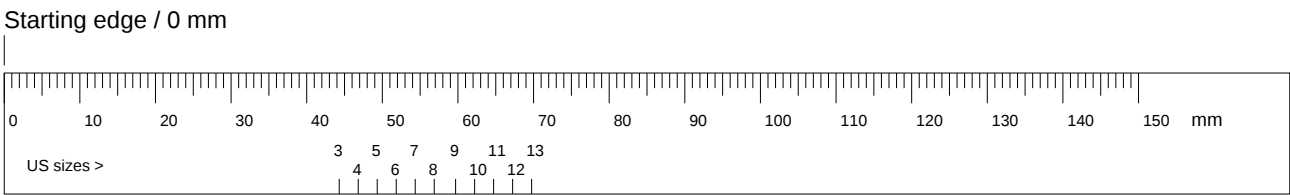
If either reference is wrong,
adjust printer settings and
print again. Do not measure
with an incorrectly scaled sheet.

2. Cut out the finger strip

Cut around the rectangle. Wrap it around the finger without pulling tight.

Read the mm scale where the starting edge overlaps. Check the knuckle too.

Repeat twice. Enter the circumference in the website calculator for more sizes.



Lower marks are approximate whole US sizes, positioned by circumference.

If between marks, use the mm reading; paper thickness and fit affect the estimate.

Have a ring that already fits? Use the matching circles on page 2.

Compare retailer sizing before ordering. Wider bands may fit differently.

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3. Match an existing ring

Place a ring flat. Match its inside edge to the centre of the thin circle line.

Labels show US size / inside diameter in mm. If between circles, compare both.
